Unit Theme: Family Ties in the church

Today's Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:3-7

Key Verse: "I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that lived first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and now, I am sure, lives in you." 2 Timothy 1:5

Questions to go deeper:

- This is a letter written by Paul, or one of his students, to someone to whom Paul wants to offer encouragement. How does he do that? Write down some examples.
- Who are the women in your life that support and encourage you in your faith? In the way you live your life? Make a list.
- Describe a strong woman. Who do you know who is like that? What do you think makes them able to be strong?

Activity possibilities:

- Color the coloring page on the reverse side.
- Think of the women in your life that you thought of in connection to the questions above. Who were they exactly? What did they do for you? How and when did they do it? Take a moment to write her or them a letter reminding her of what she meant/means to you. You don't have to mail it, although that would be very nice! You can also write the letter to a woman who was important to you but who has died.
- Find a copy of today's newspaper (on-line is fine) and scan through it for glimpses of strong women in our community. Who are they? What are they doing? How do they inspire you? What might you do to support their efforts?
