## April 9, 2020 Maundy Thursday Tenebrae

- ➤ Create a small worship space in your home anywhere. This will be a different space than what you have been preparing for Sunday mornings. It should be very plain and somber. You will need a Bible and it would be helpful to have the Tenebrae readings marked in advance if you would like to follow along.
- You will also need 5 candles, one of which needs to be taller than the rest and white. You can place these in a circle or in a line with the white one in the center. These should be let as the service begins.
- Since we will be celebrating the sacrament of Communion together though scattered you will need to have your own Communion elements

ready. We will celebrate this evening by intincture, so you will only one need cup and one piece of bread or cracker. The kind of bread or cracker and juice is your choice!

- At 6:30pm, the time we would usually gather in our sanctuary for this service, settle into your worship space and begin...
