Each session will feature Bible stories and conversations about same as well as suggested activities to help faith come alive. Here are the planned topics for Lent:

Feb. 21	"What does God look like?"
Feb. 28	"Who is Jesus and is God really his Father?"
March 7	"What's up with Lent anyway?"
March 14	"Is the Bible a storybook, a history book or something else?"
March 21	"What is prayer? How do I pray? Does God really listen?"
March 28	"If Jesus died on the cross on Good Friday, why do we call it 'good'?"
April 4	"What does it mean that Jesus was resurrected? Was he a Zombie?"
